Bus leaves at 4pm on Thursday evening (909 E Parkcenter Blvd in the Closed K-Mart Parking lot), January 30<sup>th</sup> with round trip deluxe transportation. Enjoy dinner and a movie provided on the way down. It is less than a 5 hour drive. We will be staying at the historic Ben Lomond Hotel and it is rumored to be haunted. This is one trip where roommates are definitely a plus.

The room arrangements are 2 per room. Rooms have either 2 queen or 2 double beds based on availability.

**NOTE: 10/22/2013 – All Suites are filled!**

Not priced into the trip is the availability of suites. A suite has 2 bedrooms: one bedroom will have 2 double beds; while the other bedroom will have a king or queen. The price difference for a suite is \$30 overall. For example the cost is \$10 more per person to the above overall trip price dependent that there are 3 persons to a suite. Or if 2 persons to a suite then \$85 more per person to the cost of the overall trip as the cost of the empty bed needs to be covered). If you are interested in this option, organize whom you are rooming with as they will

have to agree to the price increase, notify me, and forward the price difference in the October 10<sup>th</sup> payment.

Our hotel, Ben Lomond, is also located in the historic district of Ogden which offers abundant night life and is walking distance to Eccles Art Center, Egyptian Theatre, Salomon Center, Union Station, Megaplex Movie theatre, Treehouse Museum, Newgate Mall, Fort Buenaventura Park to name a few. Our hotel offers a free hot breakfast buffet each morning – how awesome is that! Also free internet, local calls, weekday paper, cable television, wet bar, coffee maker, hair dryer, and refrigerator. Additionally, the hotel offers free gym passes if you wish to work out or soak in the hot tub.

We will ski the day at Snowbasin on Friday, January 31<sup>st</sup> with the bus leaving at 8:20am to ski 9am to 4pm. Snow Basin offers night skiing and your lift ticket is good until 9pm close. Anyone wanting to stay into the night can purchase an optional shuttle ticket to get back to the hotel for a minimal fee. We are excited to add the Canyons to the line up on Saturday, February 1<sup>st</sup> with our bus leaving the hotel at 8am to ski shortly after 9am to 4pm. We will ski Powder Mountain on Sunday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> with the bus leaving at 8:20am to ski 9am to 4pm.

**Snowbasin** burst onto the world stage in the 2002 Olympic Winter Games. With 60 years of experience building and mirroring the legendary Sun Valley experience with its own high speed lifts, gondolas and tram whisking snow and food lovers to 4 sumptuous lodges. Skiers enjoy acclaimed mountain dining, breath taking views, and meticulous groomed slopes. The mountain receives 400+ inches of snow each season, with 3,000 vertical feet, and 113 runs: Beginner 20%, Intermediate 50%, Advance 30%.

**Canyons** is 1 of 5 of the largest resorts in North America with 4,000 skiable acres. The mountain receives 355 inches of snow fall, with 3,190 vertical feet, and 182 trails: Beginner 10%, Intermediate 44%, Advance 46%.

**Powder Mountain** has consistently earned a top rating in Ski Magazines. It is North America's largest ski area with 7,000 skiable acres and receives more than 500 + inches every ski season.
